To help your pet to live a long and healthy life, Pet Network Community Hospital is now offering vaccine & microchipping services by appointment only. No walk-ins will be accepted. Vaccine & microchipping appointments are available every other Saturday, call today to schedule. Due to high demand, we ask that you give 48 hours' notice for all cancellations and re-scheduled appointments so we may offer the available time to another pet. (No shows will be charged a deposit to re-book appointments)

Vaccines are one of the easiest ways to help protect your pet from dangerous viral and bacterial diseases helping them to live a long and healthy life. Rabies vaccines are required by Nevada law for all Dogs and Cats at 3 months of age. The Initial rabies certificate is for 1 year, subsequent certifications are good for 3 years. Proof of previous vaccination will be required to receive the 3-year certificate. Core vaccines are considered vital for all dogs and cats. Non-core vaccines are vaccines recommended by your veterinarian based on your pet's health and lifestyle.

\*The Canine Influenza vaccine is a two-part vaccine for dogs that have not been immunized for it before. Each vaccine is \$30 and must be given 2-4 weeks apart. If the booster vaccine is not given in that time frame, the series will need to be restarted at the cost of the owner. Dogs must be at least 7 weeks of age to start\*\*The Canine Leptospirosis vaccine is a two-part vaccine for dogs that have not been immunized for it before. Each vaccine is \$25 and must be given 2-4 weeks apart. Dogs must be at least 16 weeks of age to start.\*\*\*FelV/FIV testing is recommended for all cats over 4 months of age that are going to be indoor/outdoor, or strictly outdoor. We recommend getting the FelV vaccine as well, which is a two-part vaccine for cats that have not been vaccinated before. Each vaccine is \$25 and must be given 2-4 weeks apart. If the booster vaccine is not given in that time frame, the series will need to be restarted, but the test will not need to be retaken. Kittens must be at least 12 weeks of age to start.\*\*\*\*Additional registration fee may apply.
